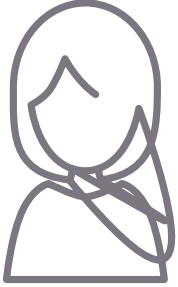

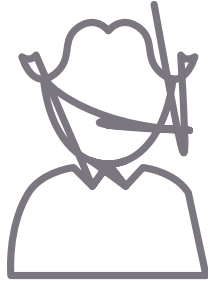

Professional Learning opportunities are provided for both teaching and non-teaching staff. A Staff Professional Learning Plan has been compiled to include support and growth in the following three areas:

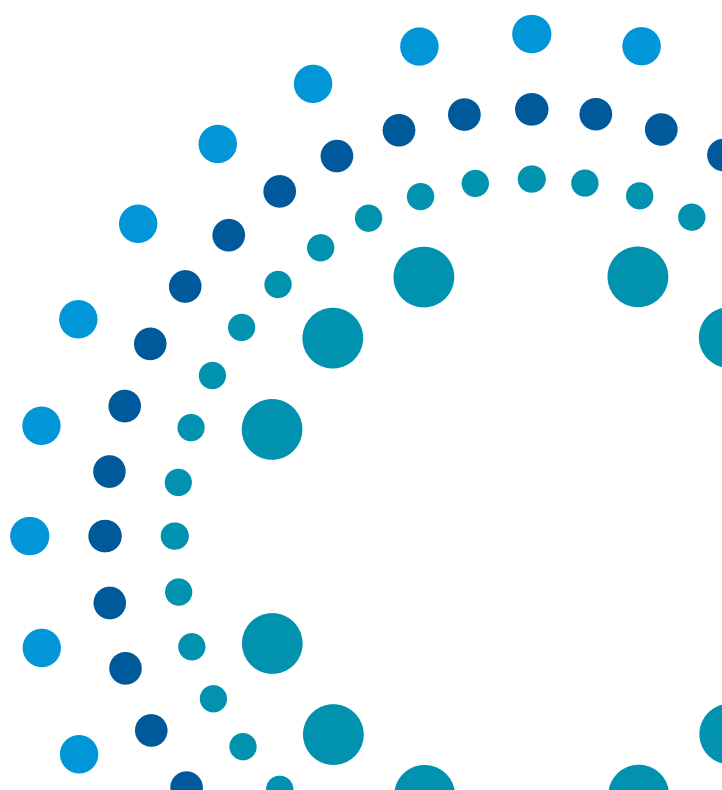
- + Undertaking annual government legislated accountable training sessions and the Lutheran Church of Australia (LCA) mandated training sessions

- + Undertaking the development of a personal folio for Professional Development programs

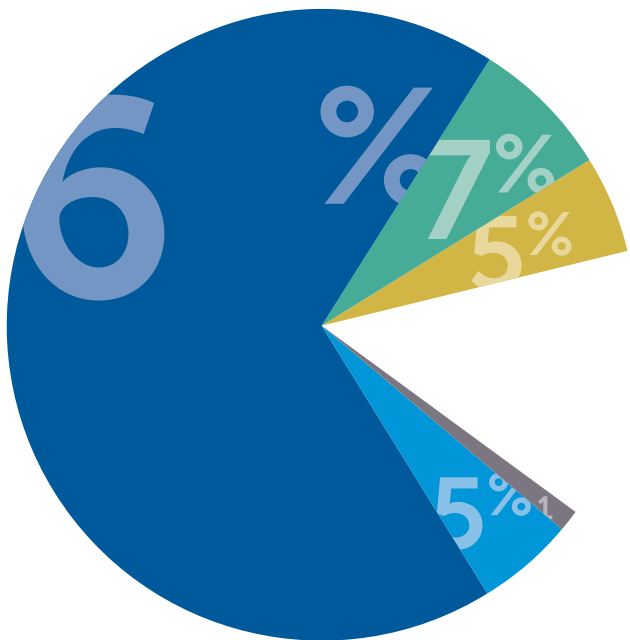
Level of Attainment
