

HARVARD REFERENCING GUIDELINES FOR MYP – Year 6

Why do we reference?

Referencing is a way of giving credit to the people who have done the research. It is a way of showing that you have read and understood what you are writing about.

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What parts of my work do I need to reference?

At Year 6, you need to reference **direct quotations**, which are words that you have copied exactly from a source.

When you use direct quotations, you must reference them. This means that you must give credit to the person who said the words. You must also include the page number where you found the quotation.

The references are listed in the following order: (1) the author's name, (2) the year of publication, (3) the title of the work, (4) the publisher, and (5) the location of the publisher.
